## Foreign/NRI Category

Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE) allocates 15% of seats for international students under Foreign / Non Resident Indian (NRI) category. This includes Foreign Citizens, Person of Indian Origin (PIO) Card Holders, Overseas Citizens of India (OCI), Non-Resident Indians (NRI) and NRI sponsored students (sponsored by NRI parents or brother / sister of parents\* or brother / sister of candidate\* or grandparents of the candidate). \*The sponsorer must be a foreign national or hold NRI status.

MAHE Manipal admits Indian & International students with qualifications obtained from Indian / International boards / University, to its various undergraduate (UG) programs in Health Sciences, Technology, Management, Humanities, Liberal Arts and Social Sciences. Candidates should meet the eligibility requirements of the respective courses as stipulated by the regulatory bodies / councils / university. Candidates with qualifications from foreign boards / university has to be recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi.

- All Foreign / NRI admissions to UG (MBBS / BDS) courses will be based on the rank obtained in the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET) and online counseling & seat allotment by Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) / Medical Counseling Committee (MCC). - All Foreign / NRI candidates seeking admissions to UG (B.Arch) course MUST qualify in the National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA, <https://nata.in>) conducted by Council of Architecture (COA). There are NO NRI sponsored seats (sponsored by NRI relatives as mentioned above) for B.Arch
- For all other courses under Foreign / NRI category, there will be NO entrance examination and admissions will be on a first-come-first-serve merit basis, subject to the candidate's performance in the 10+2 of India or equivalent examination.

For the purpose of admission, MAHE considers students from the following Board / qualifications:

10+2 of India obtained from recognized Central (CBSE/ISC) or State Boards

General Certificate of Education (GCE) 'A' Level

International Baccalaureate (IB)

Others, like 12 year High School Diploma from accredited Schools of USA; 12 years General Secondary Education Certificate of the Ministry of Education of Bahrain, Egypt, Jordan, Kuwait, Oman, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates and other Gulf countries; Intermediate/Senior Secondary / Higher Secondary examinations of the approved Boards of Bangladesh, Bhutan, Nepal, Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination of Tanzania, Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education of Kenya, etc.

Note

- Foreign Citizens with OCI / PIO and Non Resident Indians (NRI) can also apply under general category
- Candidates who confirm their admission under Foreign/NRI category on payment of prescribed fees as mentioned in the offer letter CANNOT take admission under General category.





## Application process

Applicants seeking admission to MAHE, Manipal under the international/foreign / NRI / NRI Sponsored category must complete their application through the online application form, which is accessible at <https://apply.manipal.edu/>

As part of their application, candidates will need to submit various documents, which may include, but not limited to, passport size photograph, copies of certificates pertaining to academic qualifications, and sponsorer details (passport and proof of NRI status), to support their application.

## Selection process

Candidates who have applied for various programs at MAHE, Manipal under the Foreign/NRI/NRI Sponsored Category will receive provisional offer letters from the International Admissions Office based on a first-come first-serve merit basis, based on the selection criteria for each of the programme. If any programme requires the candidates to appear for written tests / departmental tests / interviews, that may be specified and notified in the eligibility criteria, the selection would be done accordingly, and the provisional offer letters would be released only after the set process is completed. The candidates who meet the eligibility criteria and have submitted all the necessary documents would only be issued provisional offer letters.

The provisional offer letters will include essential information; details about the programme, institution, course fees, hostel fees, and the deadlines for payment of the first-year course fees. Candidates are expected to meet the conditions specified in the provisional offer letter to secure their admission.

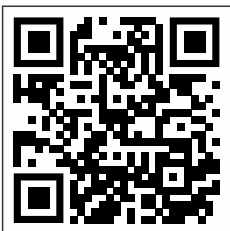

## Direct Admission of Students Abroad (DASA) category

DASA is an initiative by the Government of India (GOI) for Foreign Nationals, NRIs (Non Resident Indian), PIOs (Person of Indian Origin) & Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) only. Manipal Institute of Technology (MIT), Manipal will be one of the participating institutions under the DASA category for admissions to the 18 specializations of the 4 year Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech) program.

Admission will be based on the JEE Mains 2024 score and candidates seeking admission under DASA scheme will have to apply online and upload the documents to DASA website through their portal only. For more information log on to: <https://dasanit.org/dasa>

## Study in India (SII) category

Study in India (SII) is an initiative of the Ministry of Education (MOE), Government of India to have Foreign Nationals study in the premier institutions in India. International students admitted through SII are eligible for a fee waiver in the tuition fees, in select programs. Admission is through the Counselling process on Central Admission Portal of SII. # Student Support

## Research Excellence

Research has always been an integral part of MAHE and motivates the students to take up study projects which can contribute to science, technology and management. The surge has increased greatly after obtaining the Institution of Eminence status, resulting in a significant increase in the quantum of grants and quality of publications. To further develop its standing as a premier institution, MAHE believes at creating an ecosystem that nurtures research and innovation and incorporate the new knowledge gained into educational curricula.

To promote and nurture research activities, the Directorate of Research (DoR) formulates policies in consultation with the Research Advisory Council. DoR associates with the Government Funding Agencies like DST, DBT, ICMR, DRDO, ISRO, etc. for promotion and sustenance of research grants. Encourage strategic collaboration with international universities and organizations of repute to enhance research outcome. DoR promotes a culture of research by initiating bursary schemes, student projects and entrepreneurship, help incubate start-ups, render skill based certification programs, providing support for costing of grants, filing of patents, technical writing and mentoring at all levels.

## Internationalization & Collaborations

Office of International Affairs & Collaborations (OIAC) is the University's comprehensive resource for study abroad, research abroad, internship abroad, and other educational experiences worldwide. To underscore global credentials, MAHE has collaborated with top International universities in all fields of study which are effective in deepening the knowledge and skills of our students and faculty. By promoting intercultural competence, meticulous erudition and acquisition of foreign languages, OIAC provides opportunities for international experience. It also administers student exchange programs with partner institution around the globe.

## Industry Tie-ups

Partnerships with industry boosts innovation and help students to gain skills that equip them in fulfilling their goals. MAHE and its constituent units have affiliation with industries across the spectrum. The learning experience through these industry tie-ups empowers the students to scale higher in pursuit of a bright career.

## Student Exchange Programs

Student exchange programs are promoted with all partner universities and research organizations across India and around the world. International Association for the Exchange of Students for Technical Experience (IAESTE) provides opportunities for internships and technical exchanges for students. It provides opportunities for students to carry out their internships across the world. AIESEC (International Association of Students in Economic and Commercial Sciences) and IPSF (International Pharmaceutical Students' Federation) are other youth-run organizations that support international internship and leadership development.

## Internships and Placements

Students get an opportunity for observations and academic oriented internships in various organizations/companies across the country and abroad. This is part of the curriculum and will be for a period of 4-6 weeks. This gives an opportunity to the students to network and establish rapport with the organizations/companies which can provide them job opportunities on completion of their courses.

Institutes / Schools are focused on ensuring challenging and rewarding career opportunities for its students and have a dedicated Placement Cell who manage the placement activities for successful students. It guides the students in developing skills and job-search strategies required to achieve their career objectives. The placement cell showcases its talent pool to different companies who seek to explore and utilize new entrants. Focus is always on inviting companies with varied profiles to suit the requirements of our students looking for jobs in various sectors. Companies begin with a pre placement talks followed by tests, group discussions and personal interviews. Once their recruitment process is completed students are informed about their selection within suitable time. Different companies often have different selection criteria and process for the students.

## Facilities

The campuses at Manipal and Mangaluru have an excellent infrastructure for academic activities, sports and other extracurricular activities. The world-class facilities include air-conditioned lecture halls, laboratories, hostels, multi-cuisine food courts and sports complex. The state-of-the-art Innovation Centre, acts as an interface between students and leading corporates offering them opportunity to handle live projects. Campus provides a cosmopolitan and congenial atmosphere on which students create lifelong friendships.

**Student Accommodation:** Hostels are available for all students. All rooms are either air-conditioned or non-air-conditioned. All air-conditioned rooms have attached bathrooms. Each hostel provides facilities like uninterrupted power supply, a common telephone, television and a reading area. Students will have to bring their own soft furnishings and bed linen. Staying in the campus hostels is compulsory for regular students.

**Food Courts:** There are three food courts, one in the premises of Health Sciences institutes and two on the premises of Technology and Management institutes. All the food courts have the option of serving veg and non-veg cuisines. Membership in any one of the mess in the campus is mandatory for students residing in the hostels. Mess facilities are available at Mangalore campus.

**Library:** MAHE has some of the best libraries in Asia. There are six major central libraries. The University always strives to provide the latest and best collection of books, journals, online sources, dissertations, etc. to the students for course work and research.

**Lecture Halls:** The institute constantly upgrades infrastructure which helps to facilitate technology and smart classrooms on campus.

**Identity Card:** Each student is issued an Identity Card with the roll number of the student, which is a 9-digit number. The student should possess the identity card issued by the University at all time and are required to produce the same when asked for by the Institution and University Authorities/District Police Authority. The card is used as an access card for classes, hostel, library, etc. The card is valid for the regular duration of the course

**Wi-Fi:** Manipal Campus is well equipped with IT infrastructure with Wi-Fi at most of the locations including hostels.

**Sports:** The campuses have playgrounds and courts for cricket, hockey, football, tennis, basketball, badminton and volleyball. There are swimming pools, gymnasium and athletics track. Both, Manipal and Mangaluru campuses have MARENA an indoor sports complex, which is best-equipped sports centres in the country.

**Student Welfare Centre:** The department looks after the welfare of the students. The department's activities cover wide areas such as guidance, wellness, health and counselling. It constantly is evolving ways to support and foster students' interest in the university. A number of activities are held every year to ensure that the growth of the students is not limited to classrooms along. An active student-teacher guardian scheme is also in operation. This is to provide all help to students who leave the comfort of their homes for the first time. A Student's Grievance Cell is also in place.

**Medical Facilities:** Students are provided with all medical facilities. Medicare scheme applies to the bonafide students of the University for the entire duration of the course. A valid Student ID card issued by the University is required for availing Medicare facilities in the associated hospitals of the University. Medicare covers general hospitalization (including drugs, blood excluding diet in special wards) and outpatient benefits (excluding drugs, materials, etc.)

**Counseling:** There is a strong counselling system in place. The students find the resource very helpful as they are counseled to work through problems and difficulties. Every hostel in the University has information about it and students can visit the counselor on their own or along with faculty members. Counselling is a service assisting the students relate better with the counselor.

**Student Visa:** All foreign nationals admitted at Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE) can study with a Student Visa only. Foreign nationals with an Overseas Citizenship of Indian (OCI) do not require a Student Visa to study at MAHE.

- Candidates should apply for a Student Visa that is valid for more than 180 days in the Indian Consulate / Embassy located in their countries based on the Admission Letter issued by MAHE

- Such students on their arrival to India to start their classes will have to register with the Foreigners Registration Office (FRO) online – <https://www.indianfro.gov.in> within 14 days of their arrival in India. While registering in the FRO portal, the candidate admitted at Manipal campus should select the FRO Office at Udupi and candidate admitted at Mangalore campus should select the FRO Office at Mangalore. The documents required to be uploaded on the portal will be informed to the candidate by the International Admissions Office ([intladm@manipal.edu](mailto:intladm@manipal.edu)).
- Once registered in the FRO portal, the candidate will be issued a Registration Certificate (RC) and Registration Permit to the email address of the candidate
- A copy of the RC and RP MUST be submitted to the International Admissions Office, Manipal ([intladm@manipal.edu](mailto:intladm@manipal.edu)).

#### Notes:

- Student will have to carry a copy of the RC and RP while travelling in India as well as produce it at the Immigration Office in the airport every time they return to their country
- If the Student Visa expires during their study, students will have to apply for extension of their Student Visa online ([www.indianfro.gov.in](http://www.indianfro.gov.in)) at least 60 days prior to its expiry
- If the foreign national wants to apply for a Student Visa from their home country when they go on vacation, will have to collect the Bonafide Certificate from their respective institution / colleges or Eligibility Certificate from the International Admissions Office, MAHE, Manipal
- Foreign nationals should renew their RC and RP online ([www.indianfro.gov.in](http://www.indianfro.gov.in)) as and when it expires or if they come with a new Student Visa
- Foreign Citizen of Indian origin with an OCI are permitted to study in India without a Student Visa and need NOT register with the FRO

## Scholarships

MAHE Manipal awards Scholar and Achiever Scholarships to students admitted to Under Graduate (UG) programs under the Foreign / NRI / NRI sponsored category.

- Scholar: Based on the academic performance of the candidate, a 10% or 15% scholarship is awarded at the time of admission and subsequent years based on the academic performance of the student at the University examinations.
- Achiever: Achiever scholarship is applicable at the beginning of 2nd year, 3rd year, 4th year and 5th year based on the annual academic performance in the immediate previous years i.e. 1st year, 2nd year, 3rd year and 4th year depending on the program.

## Hostels and Mess Facilities
