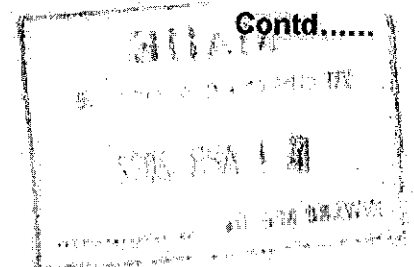
Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.MAHE/REG./UGC-Campus/01 dated June 11, 2001 and subsequent correspondence on the above subject and to say that the proposal of MAHE (Deemed to be University) for opening of its centre in India and abroad was considered by the Commission at its meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2002 and the Commission resolved as under :-

**The proposal of MAHE – Manipal Academy of Higher Education, Manipal (Deemed University) to accord permission for opening their multi-campus in India and foreign-campus abroad along with copies of the Agreement between MAHE and other agencies, in question, was considered. MAHE has requested to open its Centres/campuses in India in association with:**

1. **Surat Hospital Trust Association of Seventh Day Adventists, Surat, Gujarat**
2. **M.P. Birla Foundation Medical Society, Satna, M.P.**
3. **Manipal Hospital, Bangalore**
4. **Academy of International Education (AIE), Goa**
5. **Skyline Business School, Delhi**
6. **Institute of Ophthalmology, TELC Joseph Eye Hospital, Tiruchirapalli and abroad in association with :-**
7. **VMC Corporation Sdn. Bh.d. Malaysia**
8. **Al Ghurair Academy, Dubai**
9. **EVolution Info Tech Middle East., Al Rusayl Sultanate of Oman**

In view to export Indian education abroad, the Hon'ble Members, while appreciating the MAHE move to go abroad to Malaysia, Dubai and Oman also found the agreement between MAHE and VMC Corporation Sdn. Bh.d. Malaysia; Al Ghurair Academy, Dubai; EVolution Info Tech Middle East., Al Rusayl Sultanate of Oman – in order. It was, therefore, DECIDED that MAHE be permitted to open its campuses abroad at Malaysia, Dubai and Oman.



The Hon'ble Commission, after having examined the Agreement with the other associations, schools, foundations, etc. for opening their multi-campuses in India could not actually satisfy itself about the academic/administrative control of MAHE on these proposed multi-campuses in India. It virtually sounded like a partnership programme and did not reflect its true spirit to open a virtual multi-campus in India. As such, the Hon'ble Commission DECIDED not to approve the proposals for Surat, Satna, Goa, Delhi and Tiruchirapalli.

The Commission also examined MAHE's proposal to open a Medical multi-campus in Bangalore at its own establishment at the Manipal Hospital, Bangalore. This was found in order.

It was RESOLVED

- That MAHE – Deemed University be permitted to open its foreign campuses at Malaysia, Dubai and Oman.
- That MAHE be permitted to open Medical multi-campus at its own Manipal Hospital at Bangalore.
- That MAHE be not permitted to open the multi-campuses in India in association with Society, School, Institute and Foundation – at Surat, Satna, Goa, Delhi and Tiruchirapalli.



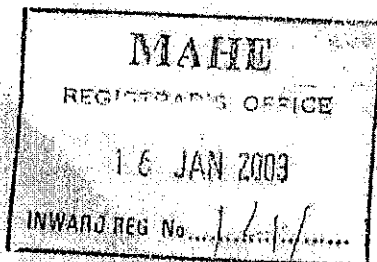

Subject: Proposal to rename the institutions started without the approval of UGC as schools and merge these institutions with the constituents units approved by the Government of India, MHRD.

Sir,

This has reference to your letter No. MU/VC/GOI/12 dated 17.09.2012 addressed to The Secretary, MHRD and forwarded to the UGC by the Government of India, MHRD vide letter No. F. 10-8/2012-U.3(A) dated 22.11.2012 regarding renaming of the institutions started by the Deemed to be University without the approval of UGC as Schools and merge these institutions with the MHRD approved constituent units of the deemed to be university. The proposal was considered by the Commission at its 492<sup>nd</sup> meeting (Item No. 5.05) held on 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2013. The Commission resolved as under:-

"The Commission deliberated on the proposal regarding the request of MAHE, an institution deemed to be university with regard to renaming of the institutions started by it, without approval of the UGC, as schools and merge these institutions in its approved constituent units. The Commission noted that during the course of the review in 2009 it was found that MAHE had started the following constituent units without the approval of the UGC:-

- a. Manipal Institute of Management, Manipal (1999)
- b. Manipal Institute of Jewellery Management, Manipal (2005)
- c. Manipal Institute of Communication, Manipal (1994)
- d. Manipal Center for Information Science, Manipal (1998)
- e. Manipal College of Allied Health Sciences, Manipal (1998)
- f. KMC International Center, Manipal (2005)
- g. Manipal Institute of Regenerative Medicine, Bangalore (2007)
- h. Manipal College of Nursing, Mangalore. (2007)

MAHE has now proposed to rename the above institutions (except the institution at (f) above) as under:-

- a. School of Management, Manipal Institute of Technology, Manipal
- b. School of Jewellery Management, Manipal Institute of Technology, Manipal
- c. School of Communication, Manipal Institute of Technology, Manipal
- d. School of Information Science, Manipal Institute of Technology, Manipal
- e. School of Allied Health Sciences, Kasturba Medical College, Manipal
- f. Institution closed
- g. School of Regenerative Medicine, Manipal Multi Campus at Manipal Hospital, Bangalore
- h. School of Nursing, Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore.

The Commission took serious note of the lapse on the part of MAHE. However, from records made available in UGC, it was gathered that the institution deemed to be university (MAHE) was already granted approval for conducting the courses by the institutions mentioned at (a), (c), (d) and (e) above in 2004. Accordingly, the Commission approved the renaming of these institutions by MAHE. Further, in respect of the institutions mentioned at (g) and (h), permission was sought from UGC by MAHE but was not accorded. The Commission, however, approved the renaming of these institutions by MAHE keeping in view the nature of the courses conducted by these two institutions.

The Commission, however, rejected the proposal of the MAHE with regard to the Institute of Jewellery Management."

NOTIFICATION

It has been decided that whereas there may be no objection to the use of the word 'University' by institutions deemed to be university, it will, however, be necessary, for the general information of the public, that universities created under executive charter are distinguished from universities established by the legislature. It has, therefore, been decided that all the universities whether Central, State or Deemed, must mandatorily distinguish themselves by incorporating the appropriate information under their name / nomenclature in the following format:

(i) For Institutions Deemed University: (established under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 vide Notification No. .... of the Government of India) (ii) For Central or State Universities:- (established by State legislature / Parliament by notification No. ....of year..... )

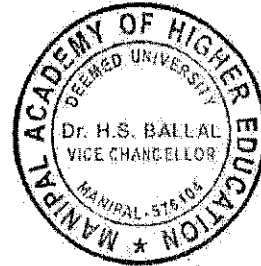

Sir / Madam,

As you are aware, the University Grants Commission vide notification No. F. 6-1(II)/2006(CPP-I) dated 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2006 allowed the institutions deemed to be universities to use the word 'University' with their names notified by the Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development. Now, the Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development has directed UGC to withdraw the above said notification in view of the Writ Petition (C) No. 8892/2009 – Prof. Kapil Kumar Vs. UGC & ors. in the High Court of Delhi as Section 23 of the UGC Act, 1956 has still not been amended.

In view of the above, the UGC Notification No. F. 6-1(II)/2006(CPP-I) dated 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2006 and subsequent corrigendum No. F. 6-1(II)/2006(CPP-I) dated 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2008 stands withdrawn with immediate effect. You are, therefore, advised not to use the word "University" with the name of the deemed to be university.

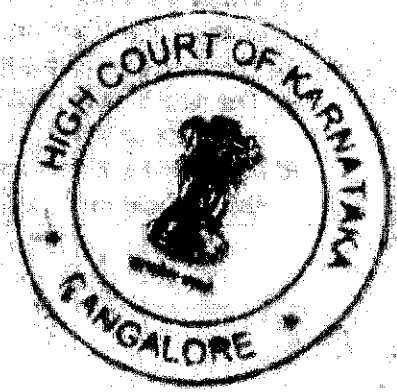

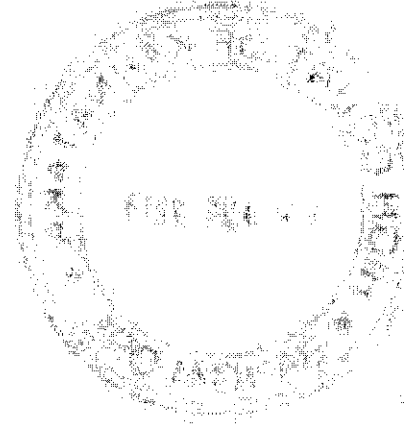

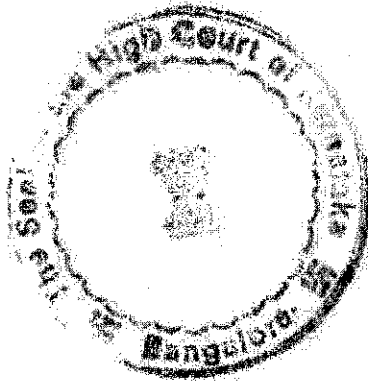
