

#### B. Faculty and institution achievements

### Part II

### A. Featured researcher of MAHE

Dr Manjunath B Joshi is an Associate Professor in the Department of Ageing Research at School of Life Sciences, Manipal. His areas of expertise are vascular and neutrophil biology. This is what Dr Joshi had to respond to about his research journey so far.



- 1) How has this journey been to you, in terms of teaching, patents, publications?

  MBJ: It has been an exciting journey associated with hard work and many failures. But there is no "simile" in life of a researcher to the happiness when we have a new finding in lab or an appreciation from senior scientists for our work in meetings/conferences or our manuscript being accepted. The moment of finding an oligoastenozoospermic male as a fertile male in CCMB, Hyderabad or constitutive activation of Akt kinase in T-cadherin overexpressing endothelial cells during my PhD in the Basel University or Glucose inducing weaker NETs or IL-6 degrading DNA methyltransferase or IL-6 facilitating disorganized vessels in breast tumours in the School of Life Sciences, MAHE are unforgettable moments in my life. Teaching and research go hand in hand, inseparable, and balancing them is a challenge. I believe that teaching concepts based on experimental evidences is more influential than just referring to text books and to be able to do this in a meticulous manner, one needs to be researcher.
- 2) What is your message to budding researchers?

  MBJ: I had an opportunity to listen to Nobel Laureates in a joint program conducted by the University of Basel and Novartis in Basel, during my PhD studies where these institutions invite a Nobel awardee every year. I remember Dr Kary Mullis' speech. He said "A researcher should be able to think of his experiments for the next day while getting asleep. This should happen at least five times a week and inherently, if this does not come naturally, then quit doing science". In other words, research is a continuous process and does not end when you leave lab for the day. I think research is not for a livelihood but it's a life style, 24x7!! The basis of research is curiosity and this is never ending. We start a project to address few key queries and towards the end, we realize that we have unanswered questions. It needs continuous and honest efforts. Grant proposals and manuscripts gets rejected, experiments fail, instruments break down, chemicals/reagents takes months to arrive, things do not work at your pace and all these are part of research life. But, show must go on.
- 3) What is your future plan with respect to teaching and research activities in your field?

  MBJ: Over the years, we have been involved in basic research in understanding the underlying mechanisms in diseases. Now, we would like to explore the mechanistic basis in translating bench to bedside. We would like to initiate interdisciplinary research to formulate organoid models for screening anti-angiogenesis drugs, microfluidics to understand neutrophil function in diabetic patients and machine learning to reveal alterations in stroke metabolism.
