First culinary arts museum

India's first living culinary museum was opened in **Welcomgroup Graduate School of Hotel Administration** at Manipal, Karnataka, in April 2018. Over 2,000 delicate and intricate utensils, objects and artefacts collected from all over India – an antique culinary collection of hundreds of years, are housed in a museum the shape of a giant pot. It is spread over more than 25,000 sq. ft, as a part of the new Department of Culinary Arts. On display are plates made by the Portuguese in India, bowls dating to the Harappan era, a 700-year-old iron vessel used to draw water from wells, artistic serving spoons, tea strainers, water flasks, copper pots, handcrafted jars and many more objects.

**The Global Report on Effective Access to Assistive Technology (GReAT) Consultation,
22-23 August 2019, Executive Boardroom, Geneva, Switzerland**

We have the pleasure to invite you to participate in the GReAT Consultation on 22-23 August 2019, from 09:00 to 18:00 on both days. The purpose of the consultation is to inform the development of a global report on effective access to assistive technology (AT), through the active contribution of all participants. The specific objectives of the consultation are to:

1. Highlight the need, demand, availability and supply of AT, and the tools/methods for obtaining these data
2. Identify the challenges in access to AT
3. Showcase exemplary national AT policies and programmes
4. Accelerate effective market shaping, AT financing and investment mechanisms
5. Showcase good practices and effective innovations (including processes) in AT production, procurement, service delivery and information systems, as well as AT workforce training and retention
6. Provide recommendations for effective access to AT

To attend the consultation, we kindly request you to register by **5 June 2019** using the WHO's online meeting system link: <https://reg.unog.ch/event/28661/registration/>.

You will find all the logistical information you need, including obtaining a visa support letter, in the online registration system.
