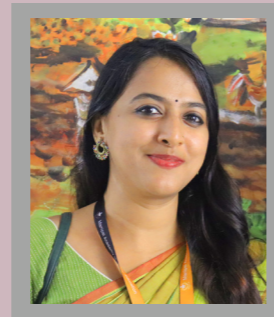

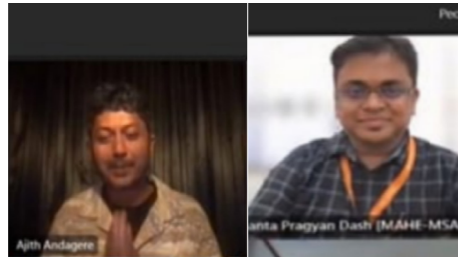
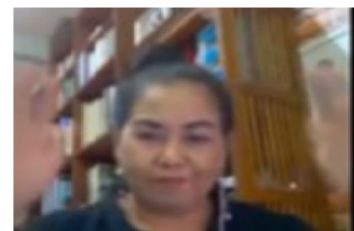
Inaugural and validictory function of the International conferences 'Sustainable Resilient Built Environment' (SRBE)

**Design of Dr V S Acharya Road by DULT in collaboration with MSAP 22nd October**

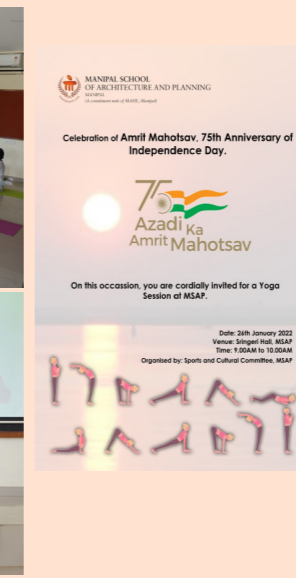

**MAHE's 30th Convocation 5th October**

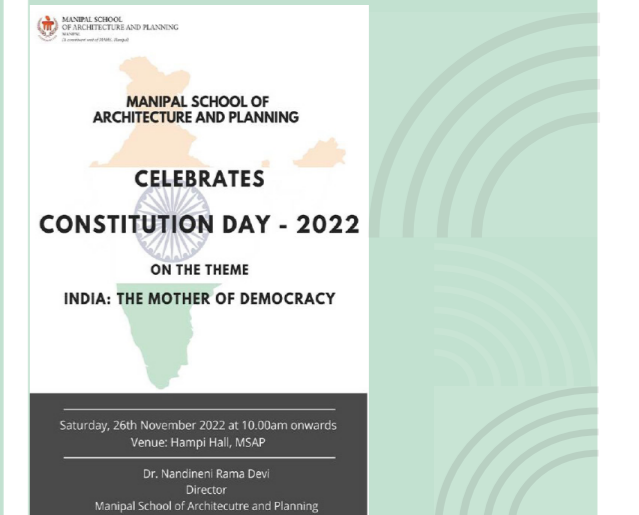

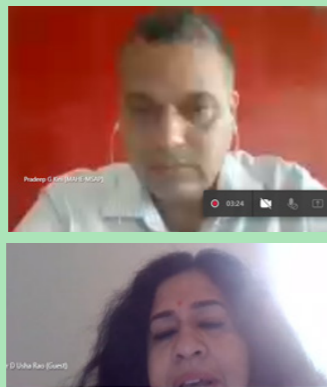

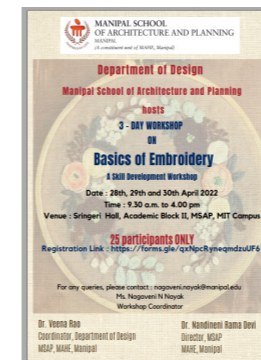


## Workshop on Fiber Extraction from Banana Pseudostem

28th April to 30th April

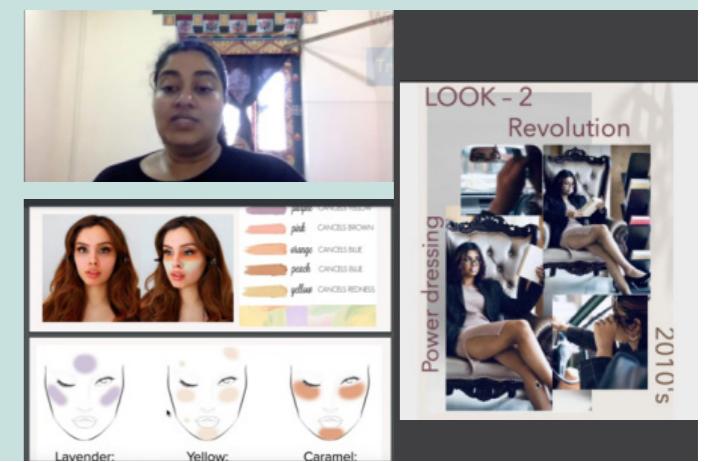

### Workshop by K S Sherigar on anthropometrics and ergonomics with human proportions

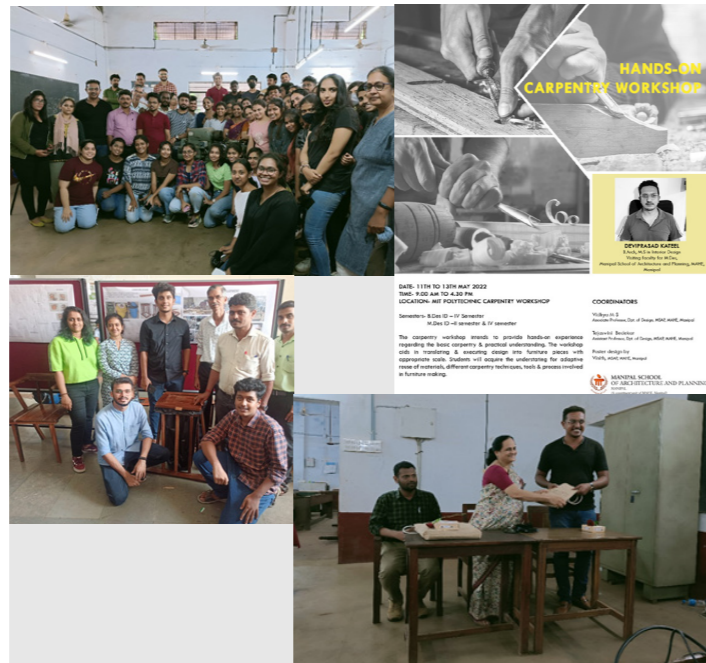
14th October

### One-day BIM Hands-On Workshop on Building Information Modelling on 22nd October

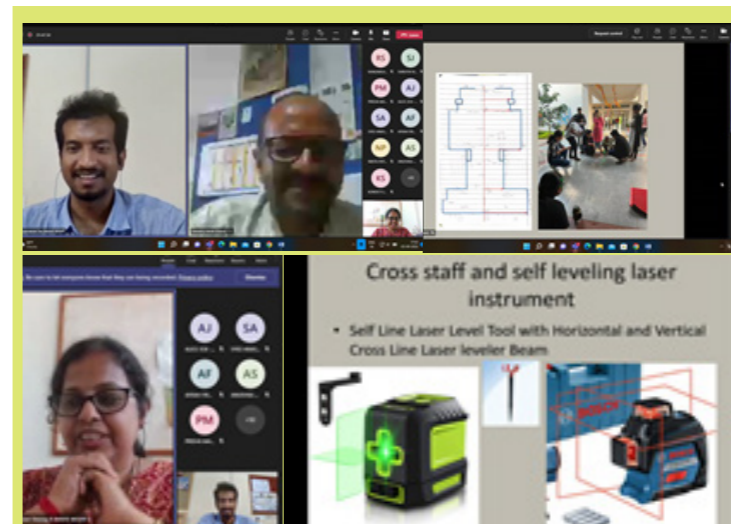
