The first page must include the title of the paper, author(s), affiliations, address, and text. Failing to conform to the standard format will result in rejection. The IEEE anti-plagiarism policy is applicable to all submissions. Detailed format information is available on the IEEE Website. All final paper submissions must be electronic, using IEEE Xplore complaint PDF format (*.pdf). Authors can use the IEEE PDF eXpress to generate complaint PDF files for final submission. The authors must agree to the IEEE copyright conditions and sign the IEEE copyright form as a part of the online submission process. All the submitted papers will be peer reviewed by the Technical Program Committees (TPC). Please note that all the accepted papers will be submitted for inclusion into the IEEE Xplore subject to meeting IEEE Xplore's scope and quality requirements. Original and unpublished papers are solicited in the following domains:
