## **About the Workshop on 'MCQs in MCQs'**

The Pharmacy Council of India has mandated, since 2017, that Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) constitute a minimum of 20% in evaluation in the pharmacy programmes.

MCQs are an important and popular method of objective assessment. Yet, many teachers are unaware of the guidelines for composing effective MCQs. If framed well, MCQs can test at different levels of Bloom's Taxonomy. A proper design of MCQs is crucial in ensuring the quality of assessment.

This workshop, will address the principles governing the construction of MCQs and will alert the participants to the inadvertent common flaws that need to be avoided.
