Mr Jo Leinen is a German politician who served as a Member of the European Parliament (MEP) from 1999 until 2019. As MEP, he took part in the Convention for the Elaboration of a Charter of Fundamental Rights for the EU. From 2004-09, he was President of the Constitutional Affairs Committee and from 2009-11 he chaired the Committee on the Environment, Public Health, and Food Safety. Before becoming MEP, Mr Leinen was Minister for the Environment in the State Government of Saarland, Germany from 1985-94. He is well known for his environmental and foreign affairs activities and holds a degree in Law and a Certificate of Advanced European Studies from the College of Europe in Bruges, Belgium.
