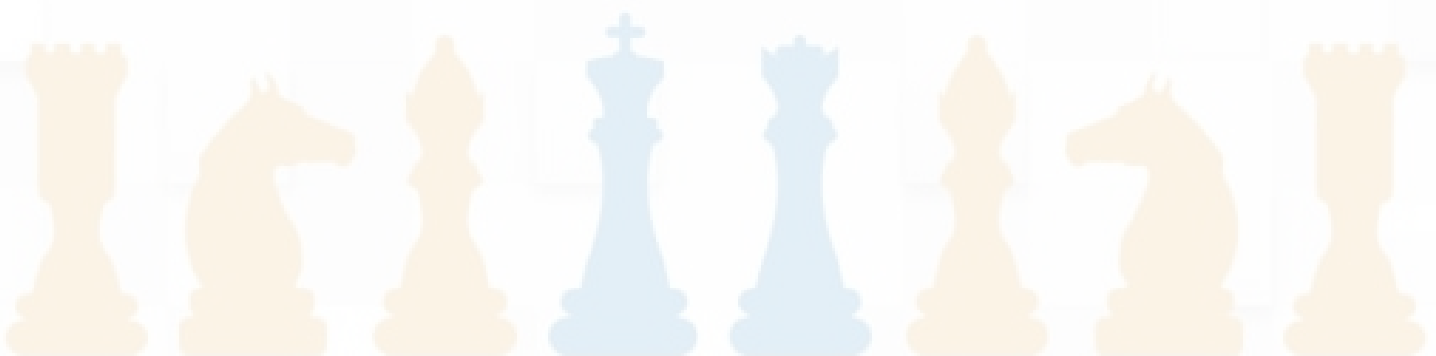

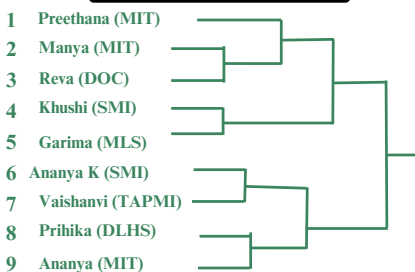
Throughout the tournament, spectators were treated to spectacular rallies, showcasing the agility, reflexes, and shot-making abilities of the players.

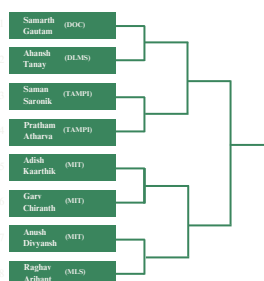

# MAHE B'LRU BALLERS LEAGUE

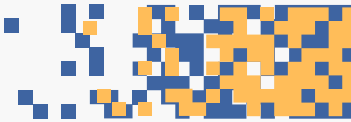

## MAHE-B'LRU PROMO RUN

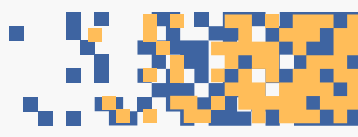
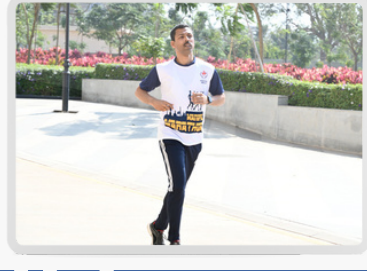
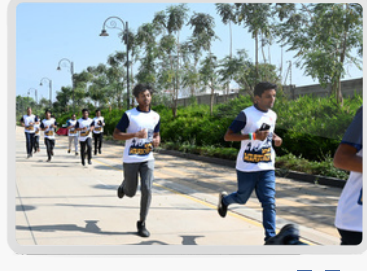
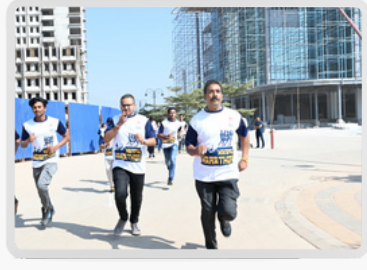
